



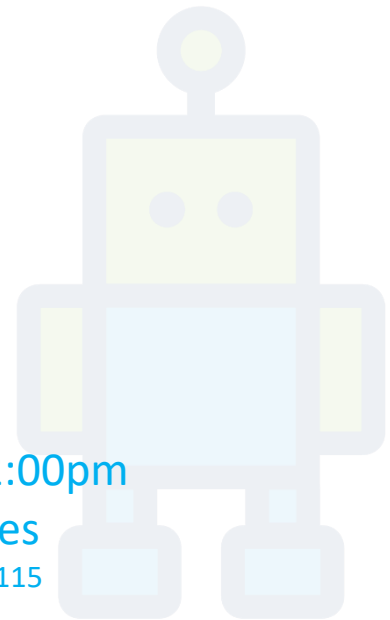

In Project Lead The Way's Design & Modeling unit (typically taught in 6th or 7th grade), students learn the engineering design process and the culminating project challenges students to design, test, and fabricate an adaptive toy for a child with cerebral palsy. Over the 10-week course students learn the engineering design process, critical measurement and mathematical modeling skills, computer-aided design software, and about cerebral palsy.
