STUDENT SHOWCASE FAQ

WHAT IS THE AGENDA FOR THE EVENT? WHAT TIME SHOULD WE ARRIVE?

We are so excited to have you! We ask that schools plan to arrive no later than 9:00am so teams have time to check in and set up their presentation tables. The showcase will then officially kick off at 9:30. Detailed agenda:

- 9:00 Registration and set up
- 9:30 Opening remarks
- 9:45 Showcase Students present their projects to professionals and have the chance to view other projects from
- 11:30 Industry panel & awards
- 12:30 Dismissal (and lunch to go)

HOW MANY STUDENTS CAN MY SCHOOL BRING?

Each school is invited to register two teams to present their projects. Teams must include multiple students (i.e. individual projects are not eligible for the showcase). On the registration form educators will be asked if they would like to bring additional teams, if space is available, we will invite additional teams on a first come first serve basis.

WHAT DO STUDENT TEAMS NEED TO BRING/PRESENT?

Each team should be ready with their multimedia components as well as their pitch presentations. Industry professionals will be circulating the showcase to view students' multimedia presentations and hear their pitches. Student should bring their multimedia components on a fully charged device (there will not be access to a power source).

In addition, small poster board displays are suggested to provide additional information and context for the development of the project. Ideally, the poster display includes

WHERE IS THE SHOWCASE?

- **Exact address:** Reggie Lewis Track and Athletic Center, 1350 Tremont St, Roxbury Crossing, MA 02120.
- **Drop off and pick up:** will take place on the Malcolm X Blvd side of the Reggie Lewis Center.
- **Parking:** available on a first come first serve basis and is not guaranteed. Please see [attached parking options](#) for the event. We suggest allotting 30 minutes for parking.
- **Dismissal:** school groups will be dismissed from the showcase at 12:30pm. Please inform bus drivers of this if needed.

HOW DO I REGISTER?

Register at www.stemweekchallenge.org on the Mass STEM Hub website. At the time of registration, we will ask for your contact info for all chaperones, school, grade level, transportation plans, and the numbers of teams (1 or 2) that you plan to bring. After registration, in early October we will follow up directly with the educator who registers to collect team information (e.g., project(s) name, student names) for the event program and to inform industry professional matching.

Parking & Transportation Options

Reggie Lewis Track and Athletic Center
1350 Tremont Street, Boston, MA 02120

Important Notes:

- Parking is extremely limited and is available on a first come first serve basis in Lot 1 or 2.
- Please plan for enough time to park and arrive at showcase by 9:00am.
- Public transportation or walking, if accessible, is recommended.
- Bus drop off and pick up should take place on the **Malcolm X Blvd** side of the Reggie Lewis Center.
- Bus pickup should be at **12:30pm**

Where to Park your Car:

- **RLTAC/RCC Lot 1 (Cedar Street)- Free Parking**
Proceed on Malcolm X Boulevard to the intersection of Columbus Ave and Tremont Streets where you'll come to a traffic light. **Take a left onto Columbus Ave** and proceed to the next set of traffic lights. At the traffic light **take a left onto Cedar Street**. Go 30 yards and **take a right** into Parking Lot 1 at Roxbury Community College. Go to the far end and park in an available space. If Lot 1 is FULL, proceed to Lot 2 (New Heath Street).
- **RLTAC/RCC Lot 2 (New Heath Street)- Free Parking**
To get to Lot 2, **take a right out of Lot 1 onto Cedar Street** and **take a left onto Columbus Avenue**. Then, **take the next left onto New Heath Street**. Go 30 yards and **take a right** into Parking Lot 2.
- **Renaissance Parking Garage @ Northeastern University – Parking Fee**
The Renaissance Parking Garage is at 835 Columbus Avenue.

Where to Park your Bus:

- RLTAC/RCC Lot 1 or 2 – see directions above
- Please see below City of Boston map for options around the city, for busses to park between drop off and pickup.

Taking the train:

- Take the **Orange Line** to **Roxbury Crossing**. The Reggie Lewis is across the street from the station.
